



The Pear Tree is named after the oldest cultivated fruit tree in New Zealand, planted in 1819 by early settler and missionary Reverend Samuel Marsden and still standing right outside the front door of the restaurant. In 2019 the tree will celebrate its 200th birthday and still produces fruit (albeit not very edible!)

Across the road, you will find the Stone Store and Kemp House, two of New Zealand's oldest buildings, dating back to the earliest days of European settlement in the Bay of Islands.

The whole area you are sitting in is known as Kororipo, taking its name from the ancient Māori Pa site (fortress) across the water to the right. This was the home of the famous chief, Hongi Hika, who controlled this area in the 1820s. Hongi is famous for sailing to England in 1820 and meeting King George IV who gave him a suit of armour and a number of guns. While in England he worked with linguists at Cambridge University to transcribe a written alphabet for the Māori language.

On his way home from England, Hongi stopped in Australia and picked up over 500 more guns. When he returned to NZ he embarked on a series of military campaigns against other tribes throughout the North Island, events that are remembered to this day.
